

IIUM OFFICIAL GUIDELINES ON HARI RAYA AIDILFITRI CELEBRATION DURING THE CONDITIONAL MOVEMENT CONTROL ORDER (MCO) 04/2020

* This guideline is applicable for staff and students celebrating Hari Raya Aidilfitri / Eidul Fitr.

- 1. The period of Conditional Movement Control Order (CMCO) aims to overcome the spread of COVID-19.
- 2. IIUM is committed in ensuring the safety of the staff and students. Therefore, the University takes all instructions by the Government seriously.
- 3. All staff and students are reminded to observe the rules and regulations issued by the authorities in relation to Hari Raya Aidilfitri / Eidul Fitr celebration.
- 4. All staff and students are advised NOT to perform congregational Hari Raya Aidilfitri / Eidul Fitr prayer in crowded mosques or musollas.
- 5. All staff and students are advised NOT to assemble in areas with crowd of more than 20 persons.
- 6. All staff and students must practice:
 - a. physical distancing of 1 metre apart at all times;
 - b. wear face masks when in crowded, confined and contact situation;
 - c. wash hands with soap and water regularly;
 - d. sanitise hands when necessary; and
 - e. observe coughing and sneezing etiquette.
- 7. All students who are on any of the campuses are NOT allowed to leave the campus, as well as receive visitors, to celebrate Hari Raya Aidilfitri / Eidul Fitr.
- 8. Celebration of Hari Raya Aidilfitri / Eidul Fitr is allowed on campus provided item (3) to item (6) above are strictly observed.
- 9. IIUM hopes that all staff and students put their safety and the safety of their families and fellow colleagues as the main priority while celebrating Hari Raya Aidilfitri / Eidul

Fitr this year. This is necessary in order to minimise the risk of COVID-19 infection among staff and students as well as to preserve the 'Green' status of the University's campuses, which are important in view of the University's intention of reopening the campuses by 1st June 2020.

- 10. Staff and students must practice **C**leanliness, ensure **O**bedience to all instructions, always be **V**igilance of their whereabout, Istiqamah/Integrity in translating instructions into practice, and **D**iscipline themselves at all times.
