### **MINUTE 444.10 PROPOSAL ON STANDARD CRITERIA OF PUBLICATION FOR PHD AND MASTER (BY RESEARCH MODE AND BY COURSEWORK AND RESEARCH MODE, CENTRE FOR POSTGRADUATE STUDIES- S.P. NO. D1538/444/2018**

#### 1.0 The Senate was presented with the following:

A proposal for the endorsement of the recommendation on the standard criteria of publication for PhD and Master students by the Deans' Council in its meeting No. 3/2018 held on 2<sup>nd</sup> March 2018.

- 1.1 The current policies and procedures for publication as a graduation requirement is only applicable for Ph.D programmes as stated in the Postgraduate Regulations (Revised 2015).
- 1.2 Due to the different practices on the requirements of publication for graduation across Kulliyahs and institutes, CPS conducted a survey on the practice.

1.3 There were two proposed options for standard criteria of publication:

**Option 1** - Standard Criteria of Publication in all Kulliyahs/ Institutes based on \*PE (Publication Equivalence)

<b>Master (mixed mode)</b>	<b>Master (research mode)</b>	<b>Ph.D</b>
Minimum PE is 1 from any combination of publications	Minimum PE is 1.5 (1 PE from indexed journal + 0.5 PE from any combination of publications)	Minimum PE is 2 (1 PE from indexed journal + 1 PE from any combination of publications)
