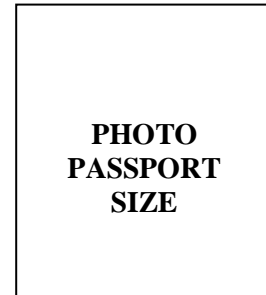

THE EXECUTIVE COUNCIL 2019/2020 session**

This announcement is to inform all postgraduate students of the International Islamic University Malaysia that the election of the postgraduate students' society shall take place as stated below:

1. Number of seats to be contested: 10 seats
2. The election day shall be decided by the CPS if the nominations is more than 10 applications.

**1. CANDIDATES**

- 1.1 A registered postgraduate student may nominate another postgraduate student who is eligible to contest as a candidate in the election by filling in the designated form available at the Centre for postgraduate studies or downloading from the website:  
(<http://www.iium.edu.my/cps/resource-centre/download-forms>)
- 1.2 The candidate is required to submit the nomination form personally during the specific time mentioned.
- 1.3 The candidate for any seat must be a registered voter and shall be nominated by one student
- 1.4 Only students who fulfill the following conditions will be eligible for nomination:
  - 1.4.1 Students who have passed through at least one semester with CGPA 3.5 and above or obtained excellent progress report. {Only students passed the language requirements for entering the kulliyah or institute} are allowed to contest
  - 1.4.2 Students who have never been found guilty of any disciplinary offence that carries a minimum fine of RM100.00 or which will subject the offender to a suspension
  - 1.4.3 Students who has of good moral character and who observe the Islamic code of conduct as required by the university rules and regulations
  - 1.4.4 Students who by leadership qualities serve as good example to others
  - 1.4.5 Students whose attire is in conformity with the rules of conduct and attire for students 1984
  - 1.4.6 Students whose are still in normal duration of study period
- 1.5 Students who have been nominated or have nominated another student are not allowed to nominate any other candidates

## 2. NOMINATION FORM

- 2.1 Prospective candidates must themselves collect the nomination form.
- 2.2 Each prospective candidate can only take one nomination form.
- 2.3 Due date for submission of the nomination form is latest by **24<sup>th</sup> December, 2018 / Tuesday, at 5:00 p.m.** at the Centre for Postgraduate Studies (CPS).
- 2.4 The list of successful candidates shall be displayed on the notice boards at the Centre for Postgraduate Studies (CPS).
- 2.5 All objections regarding any candidate to be forwarded to the office of the Centre for Postgraduate Studies 1 week before the election day.
- 2.6 All objections must be made in writing, stating the reasons for the objection and signed by the objector and shall be submitted to the office of the Centre for Postgraduate Studies (CPS).
- 2.7 The CPS's office shall review and decide on the objection submitted and the decision shall be final.

## 3. WITHDRAWAL FROM CONTESTING IN THE ELECTION

- 3.1 Candidates may withdraw from the contest 1 week before the election day
- 3.2 No re-contesting is allowed after the withdrawal has taken place as the **APPLICATION IS CONSIDERED REVOKED**
