



## **IIUM OFFICIAL GUIDELINE ON INDUSTRIAL TRAINING SEMESTER 2, 2019/2020**

### **DUE TO MOVEMENT CONTROL ORDER (MCO)**

1. The period of Movement Control Order (18<sup>th</sup> March until 28<sup>th</sup> April 2020) aims to overcome the spread of COVID-19.
2. IIUM is committed in ensuring the safety of the staff and students. Therefore, the University takes any instructions by the Government seriously.
3. All academic activities will resume on 1<sup>st</sup> June 2020.
4. For Semester 2, 2019/2020:
  - a. Face-to-face industrial training is NOT allowed until 1<sup>st</sup> June 2020.
  - b. All industrial trainings suspended due to MCO shall resume on 1<sup>st</sup> June 2020.
  - c. All industrial trainings conducted through work-from-home mode may continue until 1<sup>st</sup> June 2020.
  - d. Kulliyahs may arrange for equivalent internal industrial training programmes and assessment such as capstone projects, special industrial training courses, etc. to complete the required duration.
  - e. Kulliyahs shall inform relevant professional bodies of this arrangement.
5. Interns who are currently undertaking industrial training through 'work-from-home' mode may continue to do so from wherever they are.
6. Interns who are currently 'working-from-home' from campus are allowed to remain on campus until 1<sup>st</sup> June 2020. They will not be charged additional Mahallah fee from 18<sup>th</sup> March 2020 until 1<sup>st</sup> June 2020.
7. Interns who are currently 'working-from-home' from off-campus locations will not be allowed to return to IIUM campuses until 29<sup>th</sup> May 2020.
8. This guideline is only applicable if the MCO is lifted before 1<sup>st</sup> June 2020. A new guideline will be issued if the MCO is extended beyond 1<sup>st</sup> June 2020.
