



## IIUM OFFICIAL GUIDELINES ON RETURNING STUDENTS TO GOMBAK AND PAGOH CAMPUSES NO. 4/2020

*\* This guidelines is applicable for Gombak and Pagoh Campuses throughout the Recovery  
Movement Control Order*

### SECTION 1: BACKGROUND

1. The period of Recovery Movement Control Order (RMCO) 10<sup>th</sup> June until 31<sup>st</sup> August 2020) aims to **continue the country's efforts at curbing the spread of COVID-19.**
2. IIUM maintains that remote learning is a temporary emergency measure for addressing the needs to continue the teaching and learning process.
3. Given the recent directive issued by Ministry of Higher Education (MOHE) dated 8<sup>th</sup> July 2020 on **KEMASUKAN SEMULA PELAJAR INSTITUSI PENDIDIKAN TINGGI KE KAMPUS SECARA BERPERINGKAT**, this guidelines is updated to reflect the requirement as stated in the directive.
4. IIUM is consistent in its fight against COVID-19, and hence, adheres to the Government's directives and SOPs.
5. IIUM community must continue to practice physical distancing with social bonding, as well as the renewed normal pertaining to cleanliness and hygiene in continuing to break the chain of COVID-19.

## SECTION 2: GUIDELINES ON RETURNING STUDENTS TO CAMPUS

1. Students must request to Academic Management and Admission Division (AMAD) to return to the campus.
2. The approved names can be checked through [iattend.iium.edu.my](http://iattend.iium.edu.my)
3. Students are allowed to return to campus until 17<sup>th</sup> August 2020.
4. Before entering to IIUM, students must keep the **MySejahtera** and **MyTrace** applications activated at all times.
5. When entering to IIUM, students are required to show the personal QR Code to IIUM Authorities.
6. Students are allowed to enter campus through the main gate of the campus.
7. Only students' vehicle with IIUM stickers are allowed to enter campus. However, guest vehicle will be allowed to enter the campus for one day pass.
8. Before entering the Mahallah, students are required to scan QR code at their respective Mahallah's notice boards.
