TEMPORARY SUSPENSION ON STUDENT OUTING SEMESTER I, SESSION 2020/2021

1. BACKGROUND

The latest statistic on covid-19 positive has increased. It was reported that almost all states have been categorized as yellow zone including Pahang and particularly in Kuantan. Although the R-naught is still at 1.39, the CFS management has to take pre-emptive measures since the academic calendar for semester 1 Session 2020/2021 is now at the final quarter where the students are in the midst of completing their assignments, project reports, and preparing for the final exam which is scheduled on 5 November 2020. Hence, the CFS covid-19 task force has decided to review the previous decision on student outing. The main objective of this decision is to maximize the safety of the campus for the interest of all 4000 students, staff, and other services.

2. THE DECISION

Due to the increase in the number of cases in Pahang and other states, the Task Force has decided that:

- (a) Weekend outing for all students is suspended until further notice including emergency and medical appointments.
- (b) Visiting hours for visitors are suspended including for parents and guardians.
- (c) Residential and Welfare unit will arrange a trip to Kuantan during weekdays for students on official matters with an accompanying officer.
- (d) Off-campus student programmes will be allowed with strict guidelines and approval from the Dean of CFS IIUM.

This decision will be effective immediately from **1st until 14th October 2020** .
