GENERAL OVERVIEW



The Master of Advanced Nursing Practice programme is designed for the candidates to acquire knowledge, skills and competency in the specialise area. The programme normally requires two years of full time study basis. Student in this programme will be given clinical responsibilities in terms of patient assessment, nursing diagnosis, patients' care planning and evaluation of outcomes under supervision by the specialist. This programme also requires the student to conduct research and produce a dissertation prior to the final examination.
