



STUDENT TERMINATION POLICY

The Senate in its meeting No.455 held on 26th April 2019 endorsed a proposal to standardize the policies of non-registration for undergraduate and postgraduate as follows:

- i. A student is required to register for courses in every regular semester throughout the period of his studies.
- ii. A student who fails to register for any course by the fourth (4th) week of the semester with no valid reason as approved by the dean centre of studies shall receive a status of “NR” (not registered).
- iii. By the twelfth (12th) week of the semester, a student who retain an NR status shall be terminated (TD) from his studies.
- iv. Effective date: Semester 1, 2019/2020
