## **CONDITIONAL MOVEMENT CONTROL ORDER 01/2021**

\*This advisory is applicable to Gombak Campus only.

- 1. To ensure the IIUM Gombak campus is COVID-19-free, please be informed that:
  - i) Mahallah Salahuddin (Block G) and
  - ii) Mahallah Uthman (Block A),

will be closed from **22**<sup>nd</sup> to **29**<sup>th</sup> **April 2021**, for contact tracing and decontamination by the IIUM Health and Wellness Centre (IHWC) as per standard procedures by the Ministry of Health (MOH).

- 2. All students in the affected Mahallahs are **NOT ALLOWED** to leave their blocks during the period.
- 3. Food will be provided to the affected students by the University.
- 4. As per mentioned in IIUM OFFICIAL GUIDELINES DURING THE CONDITIONAL MOVEMENT CONTROL ORDER 01/2021 dated 31<sup>st</sup> March 2021, in Section 3 (3), The permission for students to go for outing may be REVOKED should outing resulted in positive COVID-19 cases in the campuses., therefore, the University had decided that ALL STUDENTS ARE NOT ALLOWED TO LEAVE THE CAMPUS FROM 23<sup>RD</sup> TO 26<sup>TH</sup> APRIL 2021 for IHWC to conduct further investigation.
- 5. However, the investigation period might be extended to 29<sup>th</sup> April pending on the findings by IHWC.
- 6. Academic Management and Admission Division (AMAD) and Mahallah Salahuddin office are closed from 22<sup>nd</sup> April to 1<sup>st</sup> May 2021.
- 7. Office of International Affairs is closed from 20<sup>th</sup> to 29<sup>th</sup> April 2021.
- 8. All staff of the affected offices is required to work from home.
- 9. All staff and students must:
  - a. practice physical distancing of 1 metre apart at all times;
  - b. avoid the **3C** (Crowded, Confined and Closed conversation);
  - c. practice the **3W** (Wash hands, Wear mask and Warn);
  - d. observe appropriate coughing and sneezing etiquette.

- 10. All staff and students must immediately and directly report to IHWC (General Line: 03-6421 4444) if you have had a close contact with:
  - a. someone tested/suspected positive for COVID-19; and/or
  - b. Person Under Investigation (PUI).
  - c. Person Under Surveillance (PUS)
- 11. All shall be subject to action under the Prevention and Control of Infectious Disease Act 1988 (Act 342) for failure to declare, or false declaration of your health condition and/or contact tracing situation; or intentionally refuse to provide any relevant information as required by the University authority.
- 12. Any student caught leaving the campus illegally will be placed in isolation at designated Mahallah for 10 days and shall be subjected to further disciplinary actions by the University.
