









IIUM OFFICIAL ANNOUNCEMNENT DURING THE ENHANCED MOVEMENT CONTROL ORDER EMCO 03/2021

* This announcement is applicable to the staff and students of International Islamic University Malaysia (IIUM), Gombak Campus.

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SECTION 1: GENERAL RULES

- 1) The period of the Enhanced Movement Control Order aims to reduce individual contact to avoid the spread of COVID-19.
- 2) In light with the recent increase in the number of COVID-19 cases and the multiple clusters identified nationally, it is with regret to inform that a number of COVID-19 positive cases has been diagnosed among students of IIUM Gombak campus.
- 3) Due to an increasing number of positive COVID-19 cases involving students, with the advice of relevant authorities, the university has decided to take precautionary measures to ensure the safety of IIUM community.
- 4) Staff and students must immediately and directly report and/or go to IHWC

if you have had:

- i. any COVID-19 symptoms; and/or
- ii. close contact with someone tested positive for COVID-19 and/or a Person Under Surveillance (PUS).
- All shall be subjected to action under the Prevention and Control of Infectious Disease Act 1988 (Act 342) for failure to declare, or false declaration of your health condition and/or contact tracing situation; or intentionally refuse to provide any relevant information as required by the University authority.
- 6) Any students caught leaving the campus illegally shall be subjected to further disciplinary actions by the University.
- 7) All staff and students must:
 - a. practice physical distancing of 1 metre apart at all times;
 - b. avoid the **3C** (Crowded, Confined and Closed conversation);
 - c. practice the **3W** (Wash hands, Wear mask and Warn);
 - d. observe appropriate coughing and sneezing etiquette.
- 8) Students who are staying off-campus are not allowed to enter Gombak campus.
- 9) Students are not allowed to be at Kulliyyah, Centres, Divisions, Institutes and Offices areas after 8:30pm.
- 10) All students must be in their respective Mahallahs after 8.30pm
- 11) Food delivery is still to be allowed with strict SOP.

12) All staff and students must practice physical distancing and good hygiene wherever they are.

SECTION 2: ANNOUNCEMENT FOR STUDENTS

- 1) Students on Gombak campus **MUST** observe the rules and regulations of the University.
- 2) Since there are significant increase in number of COVID-19 positive cases involving students and close contact, the university has to make necessary changes to the students' accommodation arrangement.
- 3) This is to ensure the effectiveness of the isolation process.
- 4) As for now, 6 blocks at 3 Mahallahs are being utilized as isolation centres as follows:

5) 3 more blocks at Mahallah Uthman and Zubair are currently being utilized as additional isolation centres as follows:

- 6) Therefore, the management will make changes to the accommodation arrangement to centralise the isolation centres to ensure the effectiveness of the process.
- 7) Mahallah Zubair will be the main and only isolation Mahallah for brothers.
- 8) Mahallah Safiyyah will remain as isolation centre for sisters.
- 9) Below is the transfer schedule involving students at the affected Mahallahs.
