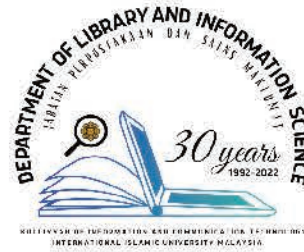


ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS

- A** A good master's degree in LIS or Information Management from IIUM or other academic institutions recognized by the IIUM or the Public Services Department with a minimum CGPA of 3.00 or equivalent
- B** A good master's degree in any disciplines from IIUM or other academic institutions recognized by the IIUM or the Public Services Department or equivalent. Upon admission, the student will be required to take pre-requisite in the form of prescribe courses in the MLIS program
- C** Candidates who have long experience working in the information and knowledge related fields, have published numerous publications and articles in referred journals and have shown aptitude for research and scholarly discourse may also be considered if proper proposal related to Library and Information Science disciplines is submitted with the admission form

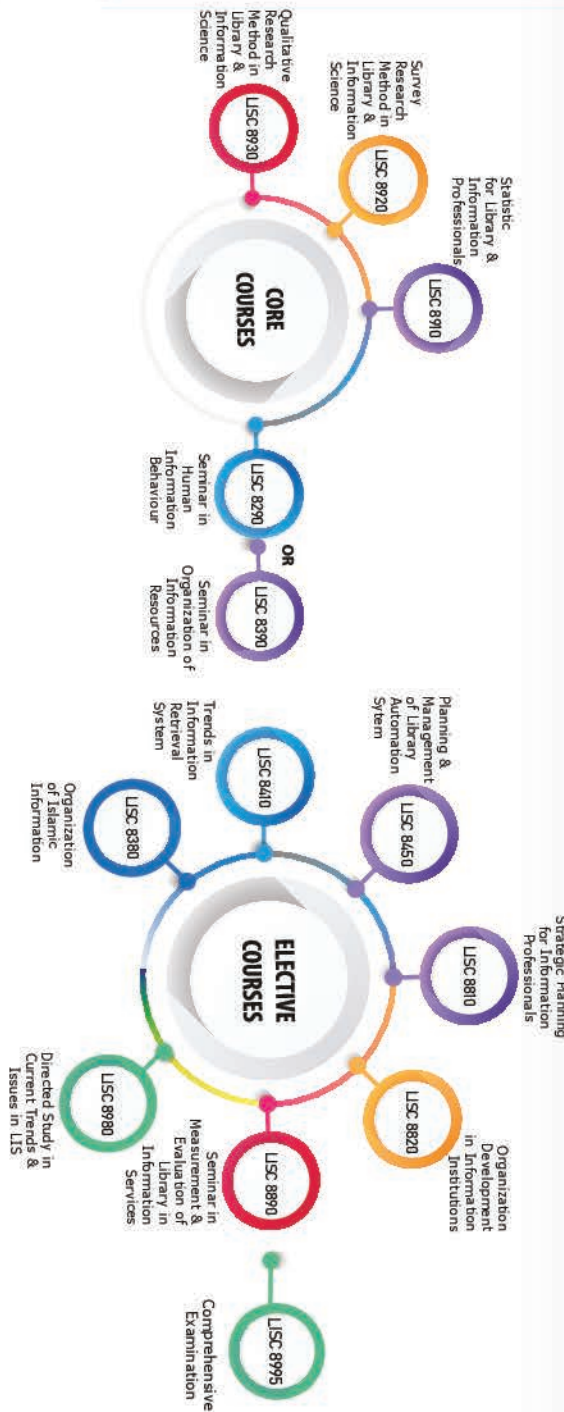
