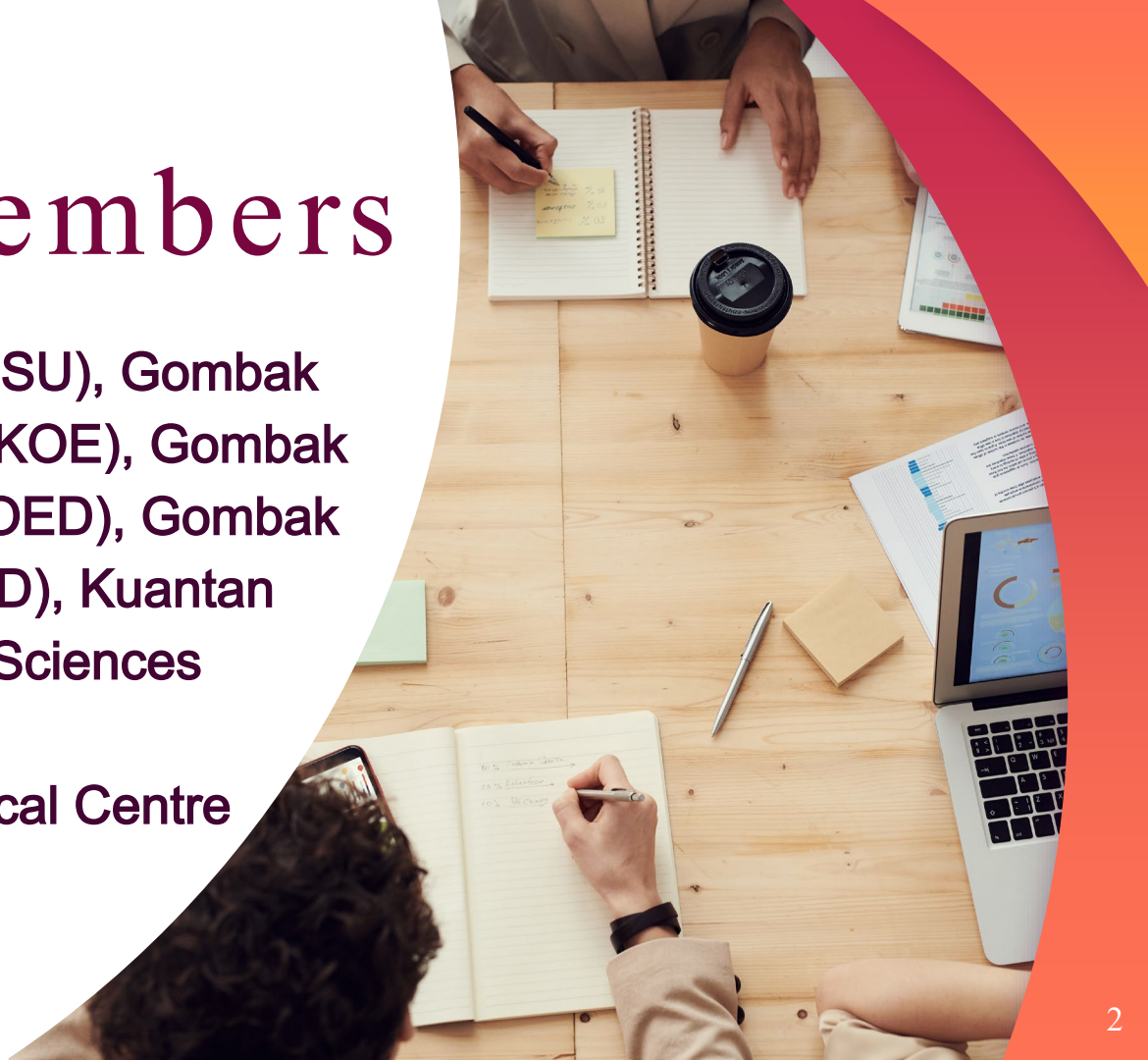

COMPONENT 1

OKU Orang Asli Pilot Project

- To assist the OKU orang asli children to excel either in academic or other skills for their economic independence and wellbeing in the future (Outcome: Standard 6 students – able to enter boarding school; Form 5 students able to achieve good SPM results and able to enter university)
- To motivate the families of OKU Orang Asli that academic success is not impossible
- To enable and empower OKU Orang Asli children and students through mentoring and skills enhancement program

COMPONENT 2

OKU Islamic Outreach Project

- To eliminate negative perception on OKU and Disability Discrimination and understanding of the meaning of equal opportunities towards OKU
- To enhance awareness and empathy towards OKUs at national, state and community levels
- To create a central portal that places as many links to information on Islamic education for special needs children and individuals to assist parents and OKU Muslim community easier access to Islamic education.

COMPONENT

OKU Sejahtera

- To enhance OKU Orang Asli wellbeing through health, dental and hearing screening and follow up treatments, therapies and hearing aid/ cochlear implant assistance
- To enhance OKU physical wellbeing through on-campus rehabilitation facility
- To enhance overall living conditions through accessibility upgrading projects
- To set up an early interventional inclusive education program centre (Taska/ Tadika inklusif) for IIUM Kampus Kuantan staffs' children and surrounding area.
- To develop a module for Autism Rehabilitation Centre in Perlis
