### Programme Structure

The master programme is a scientific foundation course for the Doctorate in Clinical Dentistry.

The programme of study shall consist of major or compulsory courses such as: Research Design & Biostatistics, Multidisciplinary Health Sciences/Community Dental Practice, Core Medical & Oral Sciences and together with the elective course (Orthodontics).

The master programme courses, professional examination, continuous assessments and the research proposal must each be completed satisfactorily and passed.

### Duration of Study

- Full time only
- Minimum 1 year (2 semesters); maximum 2 years (4 semesters)

## MASTER OF SCIENCE IN DENTISTRY (MScD) / MASTER OF OROFACIAL SCIENCES (MOFSc) & DOCTOR IN ORTHODONTICS (DrOrth) (1+3 Dental Specialty Programme)

### SEPT 2022 INTAKE

This application is for the 1+3 programme of Master of Science in Dentistry (UiTM) / Master of Orofacial Sciences (MAHSA) followed by Doctor in Orthodontics (IIUM).

### Required documents:

- 5) Research Proposal
- 6) Two Referee Reports
- 7) IELTS certificate of at least band 7.0
- 8) Letter from Employer (evidence of minimum of 2 years' experience)
- 9) Proof of funding
- 10) Primary examinations certificate (BMS/FACDS/MJDF/MFDS) if any
- 11) Annual Practising Certificate (APC)
- 12) Application processing fee (RM100 for Malaysian/USD100 for International)

### Entry Requirements:

- 1) Applicant with Bachelor of Dental Surgery or equivalent qualifications
- 2) A minimum of 2 years clinical practice after basic degree, excluding the Master's training
- 3) Registered with MDC and hold current APC or registered with the dental regulatory body in another country and eligible to be granted a Temporary Practising Certificate (TPC) by the MDC
- 4) Health clearance according to UiTM/MAHSA and IIUM policy.
- 5) 2 referee reports
- 6) Passed entrance interview
- 7) Successful completion of the primary examination of the Joint Dental Faculties MJDF/MFDS/IMOrth or equivalent is desirable
- 8) IELTS overall band of at least 7.0

### Health Status:

Applicants to clinical programmes need to provide evidence to the University that they are free from Hepatitis B and Hepatitis C upon acceptance into the programme.

## DOCTOR IN ORTHODONTICS (DrOrth), IIUM

Upon successful completion of the MScD (UiTM) / MOFSc (MAHSA), residents shall proceed to enroll in the Doctor in Orthodontics (IIUM), a three-year doctorate Level 8 MQF programme.

### Programme Structure

This course is designed to provide clinical and academic training for future specialists in clinical orthodontics in a highly professional and fulfilling environment.

This three-year full-time course aims to equip a resident with the skills needed to perform as a competent Specialist in Orthodontics, with focus on the clinical, theoretical and research areas required for provision of adequate patient care.

Upon successful completion of the course, the resident will be awarded with the qualification of Doctor in Orthodontics IIUM.

2. Dissertation – ORTH8048
3. Unified Islamic Course (University Required Course) – ORTH8002
