This unit handles research and consultancy related to Universal Design and Accessibility for Persons with Disabilities (PwDs), elderly and children. She obtained her PhD from Oxford Brookes University in Oxford, United Kingdom in 1994. Her Bachelor of Architecture from our local University of Technology Malaysia (UTM). She was involved in teaching heritage studies locally and abroad in collaboration with other universities. For example, Masjid Banten in Indonesia; Istana Leban Tunggai in Pekan, Pahang; Haghighi House in Isfahan, Iran; 3 private houses in Damascus, Syria; China; Sekolah Batu Lama, PULAPOL, Kuala Lumpur, Malaysia other heritage works

with IIUM Landscape Architecture students in Granada, Spain and India. Many of her works on heritage have been published for examples 'Access Audit In Religious Building and Public Spaces in Damascus City, Syria', 'Accessible Built Environment For the Elderly And Disabled In Malaysia: Hotels As Case Study', 'Housing in Islamic Perspective: Brunei As a Case Study', 'Keperluan Pengguna dan Reka Bentuk Bangunan untuk Orang Tua Di Malaysia', 'IBS Towards Open Building Systems In Malaysia', 'Architectural Heritage Study in Iran: Haghighi House', 'From Bukit Tinggi To Negeri Sembilan' and others. She is an active researcher and consultant for issues related to the design of persons with disabilities (PwDs), design for the ageing population/elderly and responsive design of people perceptions and people needs/requirements for various organisations. She is the chairperson for several Malaysian Standards (MS) related to Accessibility, Public Toilet, Mosque and Industrialized Building System (IBS). She has been invited as keynote speaker and presenting papers locally within Malaysia and internationally in Harvard, United Kingdom, United States of America, Sweden, Norway, Germany, Spain, Switzerland, Turkey, Singapore, Brunei, Australia, China, Saudi Arabia, Sri Lanka, India, Japan, South Korea, Syria, Iran, Indonesia, Thailand, Pakistan, Ireland and several more other countries to be mentioned, for talks and presentation in International conferences, symposiums, seminars and world forum.



Dr Srazali Aripin is currently an Assistant Professor at the Department of Architecture, Kulliyyah of Architecture and Environmental Design (KAED), International Islamic University Malaysia (IIUM). He obtained his Doctor of Philosophy in Architecture (thesis entitled "Healing Architecture": A study of daylight in public hospital designs in Malaysia) from the University of Queensland, Brisbane, Australia in 2010. He has been active in presenting his works at local and international conferences including at the 8th World Congress & Exhibition on Design & Health, in Kuala Lumpur Convention Centre, Malaysia (2012) and at the First Saudi Forum for Planning & Design of Hospitals in Riyadh, (2013). His works have also been published in the Arab World Geographer (vol. 13, no. 2, 2010, pp. 138-149, a Scopus indexed journal). He has earned several awards including Gold Award at IIUM Research, Invention and Innovation Expo, (IRIIE, 2013); the prestigious Royal Institute of British Architects (RIBA) University Awards from British Gas (1991); the Pilkinton Building Science Award (1992) and GRADUS Degree

Award (1992). Dr Srazali Aripin has worked as an architect for five years prior to joining the academic fraternity in 2000. He is a registered graduate member of the Lembaga Arkitek Malaysia (LAM) and Malaysian Institute of Architects (PAM). He currently serves as an accreditation panel member in the Majlis Akreditasi dan Pengajian Senibina Malaysia (MAPSM).
