❖ [مقاصد الشريعة] [The Objectives of Shari'ah]

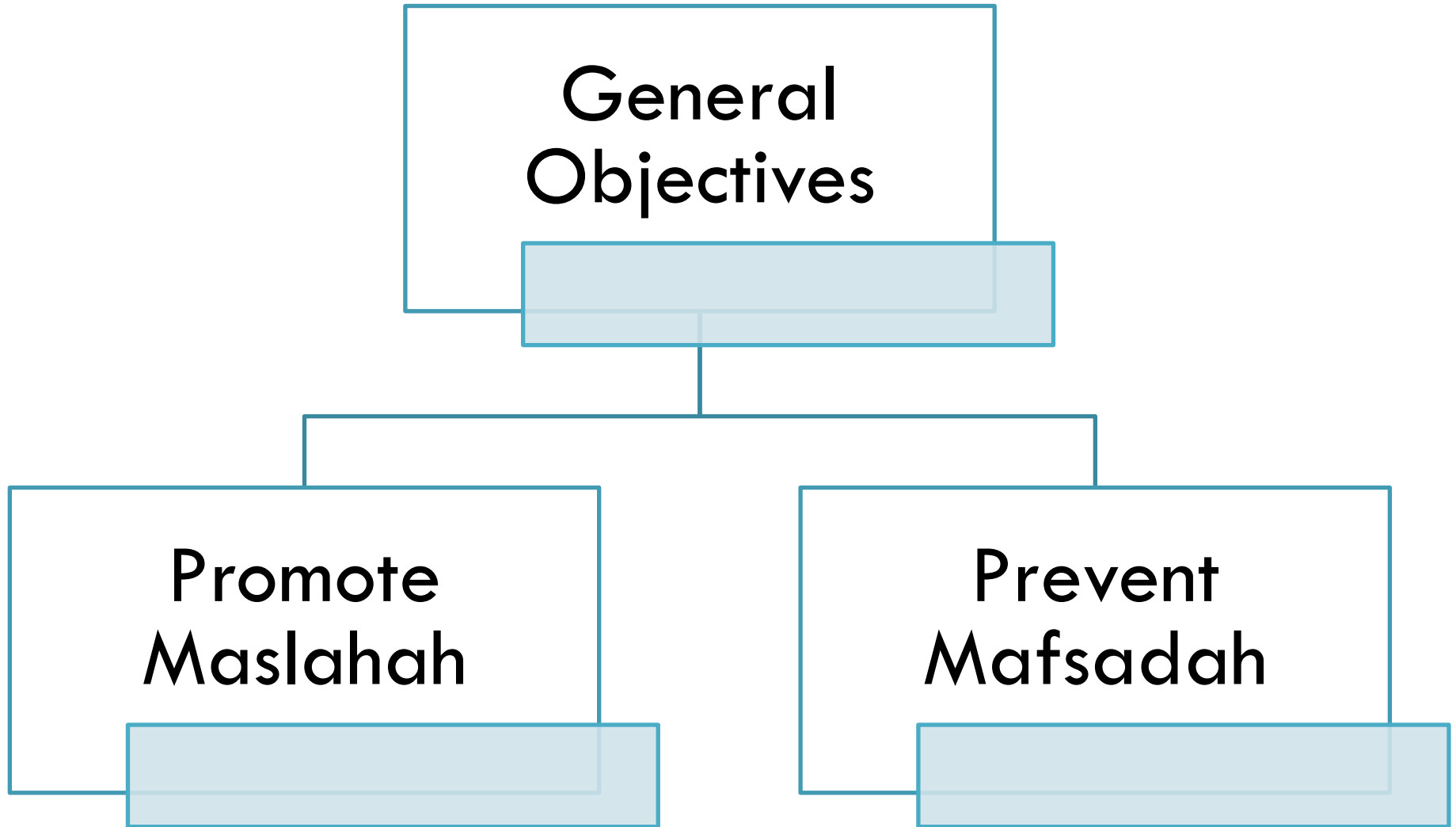
❖ [مقاصد الشارع] [The Objectives of the Law Giver]

❖ [المقاصد الشرعية] [The Shari'ah related objective]

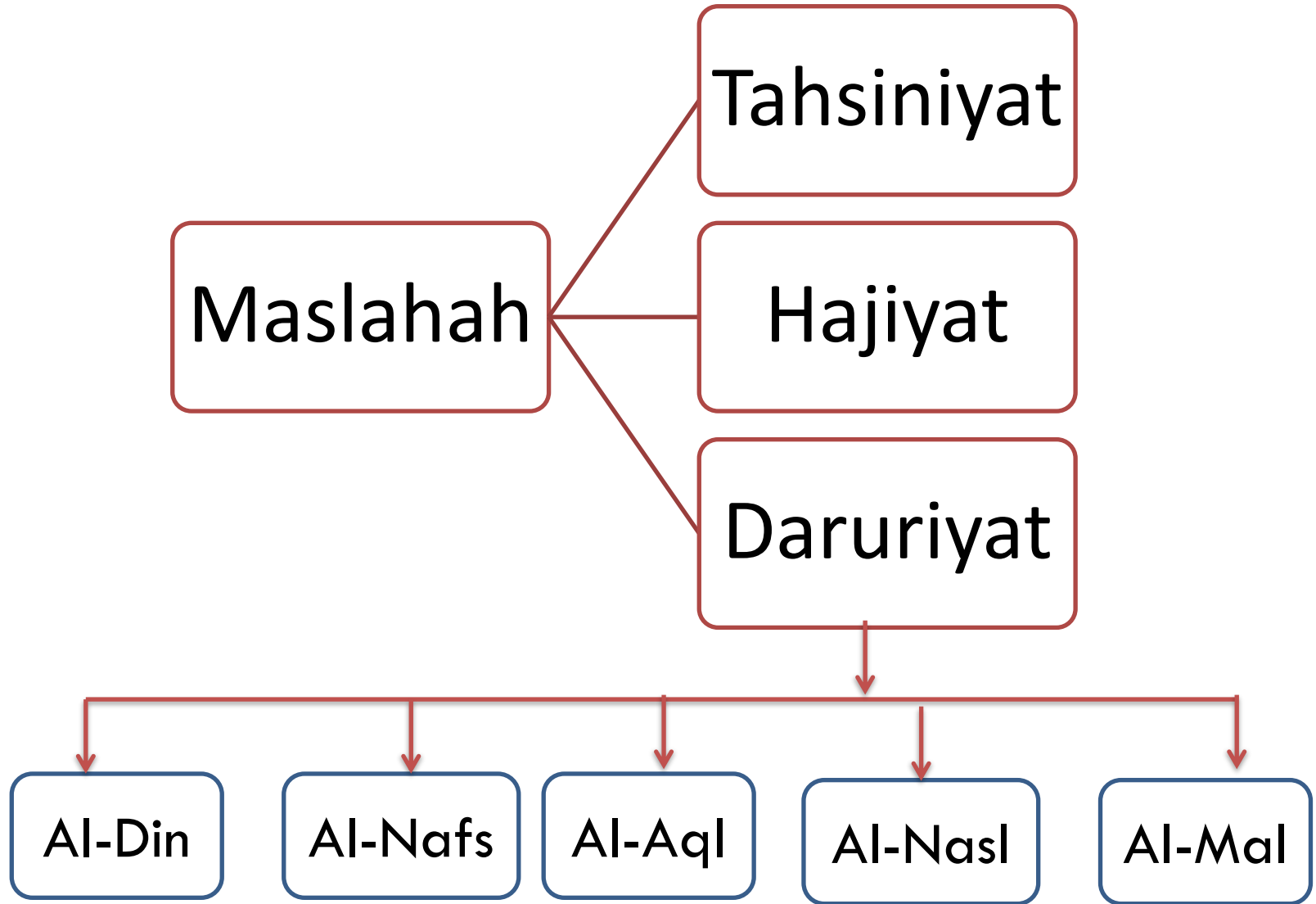
Theory of al-Maqasid

- ❖ His student al-Ghazali refined it to 3 levels

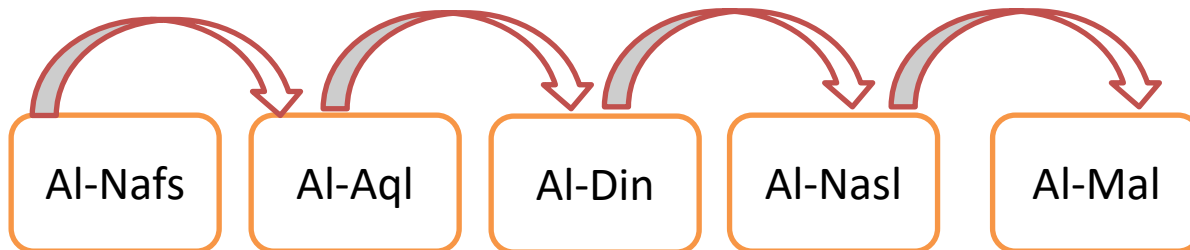
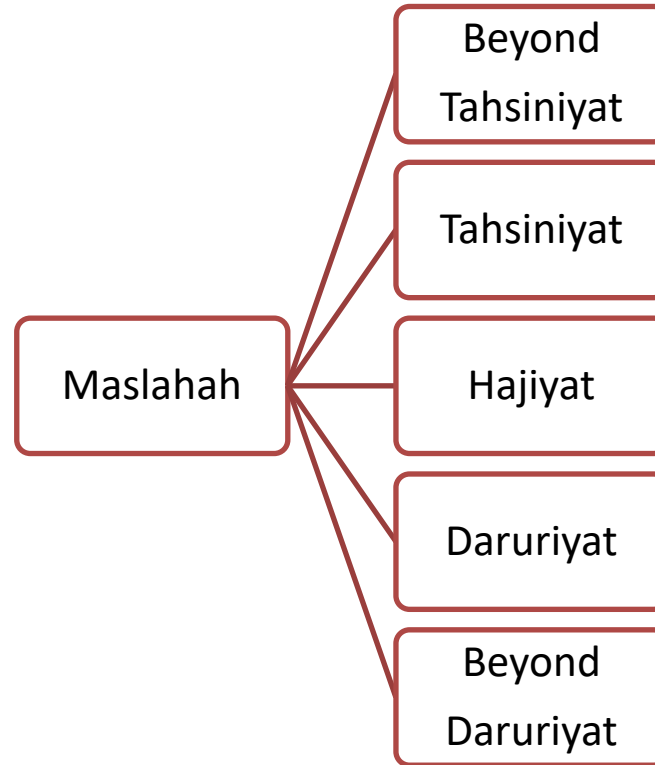

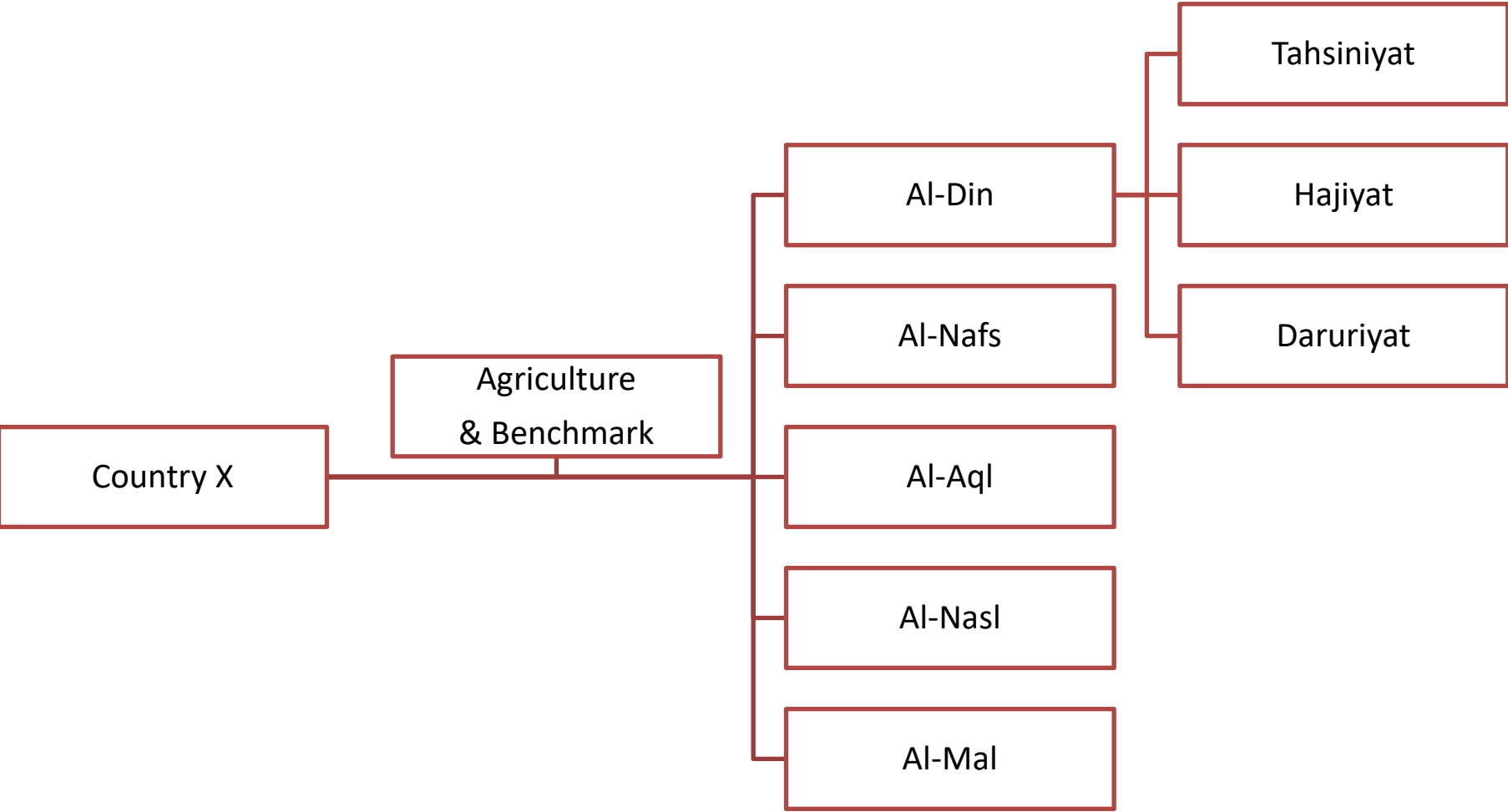
- ❖ Maqasid has several applications

Maqasid and Resource Allocation: Macro Perspective

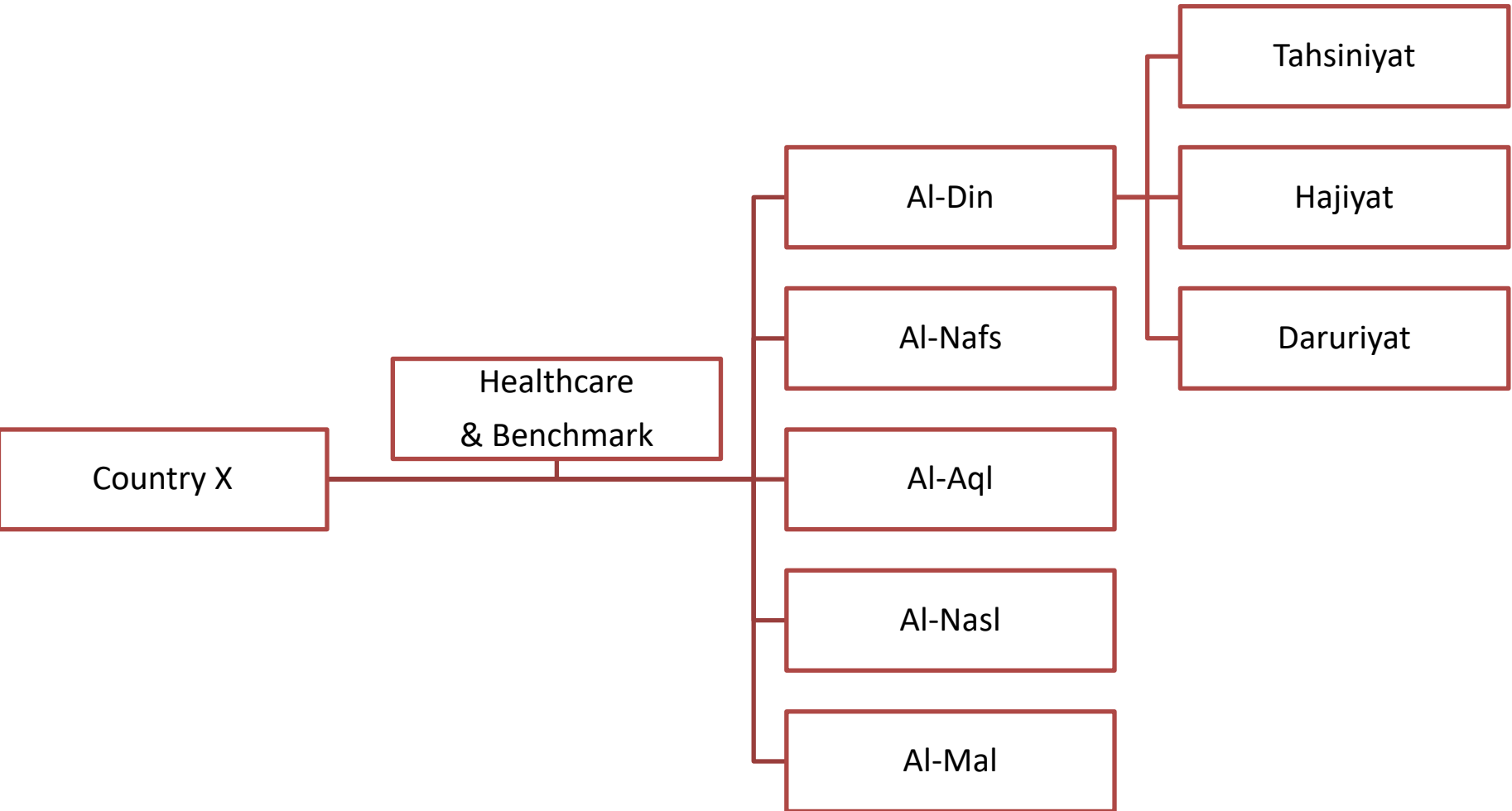
- ❑ Objective is to evaluate based on al-Maqasid, the extent to which select Muslim countries allocate resources in the following sectors:

- ❑ Data obtained were evaluated based on the 3 levels of Maslahah and 5 levels of Maqasid

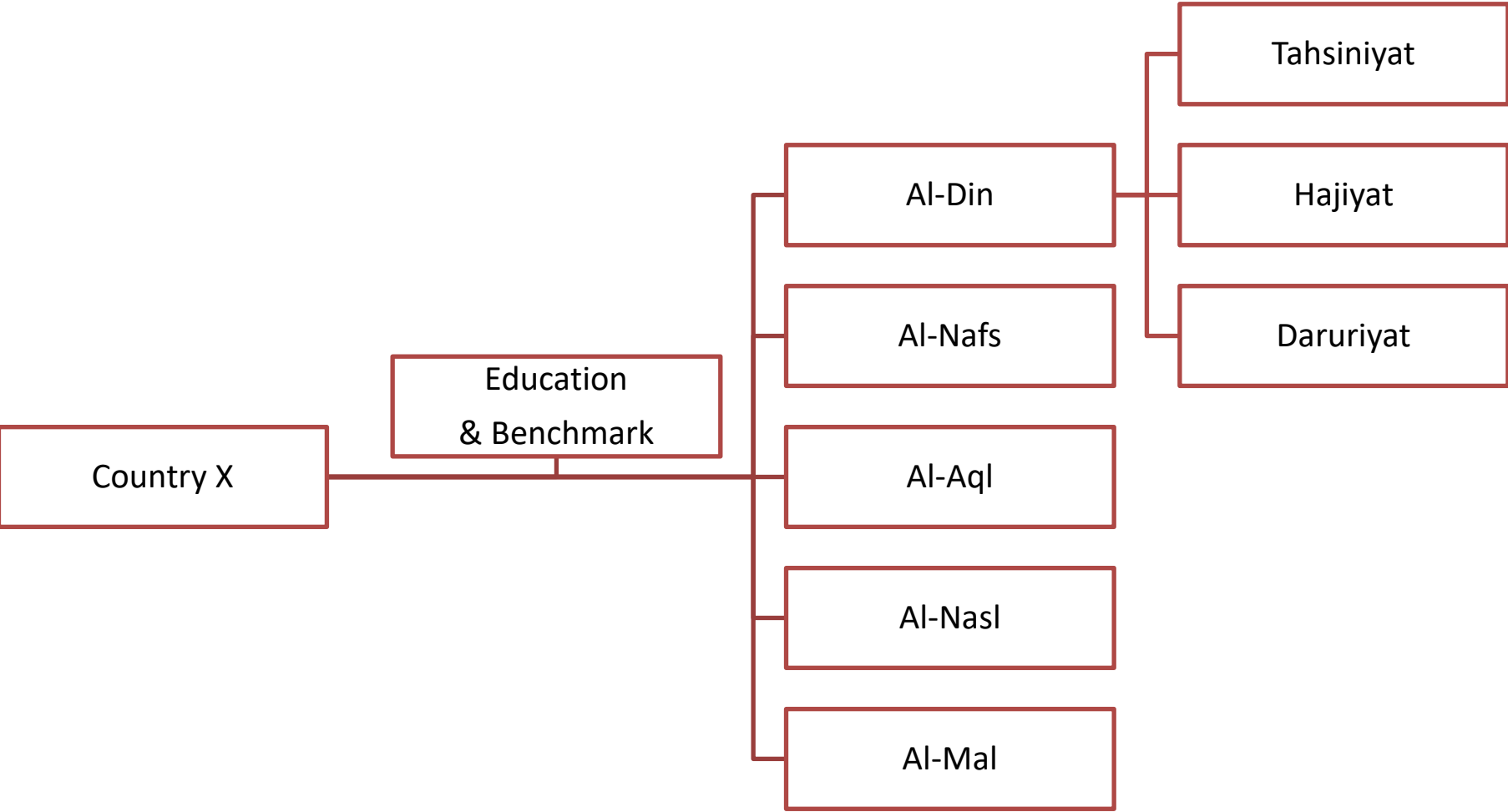
