It questions common assumptions about higher education and its contributions, in so doing creating a bold series of possibilities for different – and better – futures for higher education for all.

The report is the first phase of a multi-phased project on the Futures of Higher Education being undertaken by UNESCO IESALC during 2021. The project is being undertaken within the framework of UNESCO's Futures of Education flagship initiative, which aims to "rethink education and shape the future".

The webinar will begin with welcoming remarks by Francesc Pedró, UNESCO IESALC Director; and a representative of the Future of Learning and Innovation Team, UNESCO.

The report will be official launched by Emma Sabzalieva, UNESCO IESALC Senior Policy Analyst and the coordinator of the consultations. Following this, experts who were involved in the consultations will offer brief interventions on what the futures of higher education could look like.
